To whom it may concern,

We've been made aware of a traveller settlement in Nantyglo where the residents have carried out extensive excavations of the land, we believe in order to put homes there. This has caused considerable concern among local residents due to fears of a potential landslip – and some people also claim to have faced intimidation from those carrying out the work. The site is to the rear of Nantyglo Rugby Club.

Can I ask if the Council is aware of the development?

Has planning permission been granted?

Has the council been in talks with the group carrying out the work, or consulted with local residents?

Does the council have plans to prevent the work from continuing? If so, is this at least in part because of any safety concerns?

Does the council propose restoring the land and if so, how will this work be funded?

May I also ask if anyone from the council would be able to be interviewed on camera by our reporter, Steve Fairclough?
