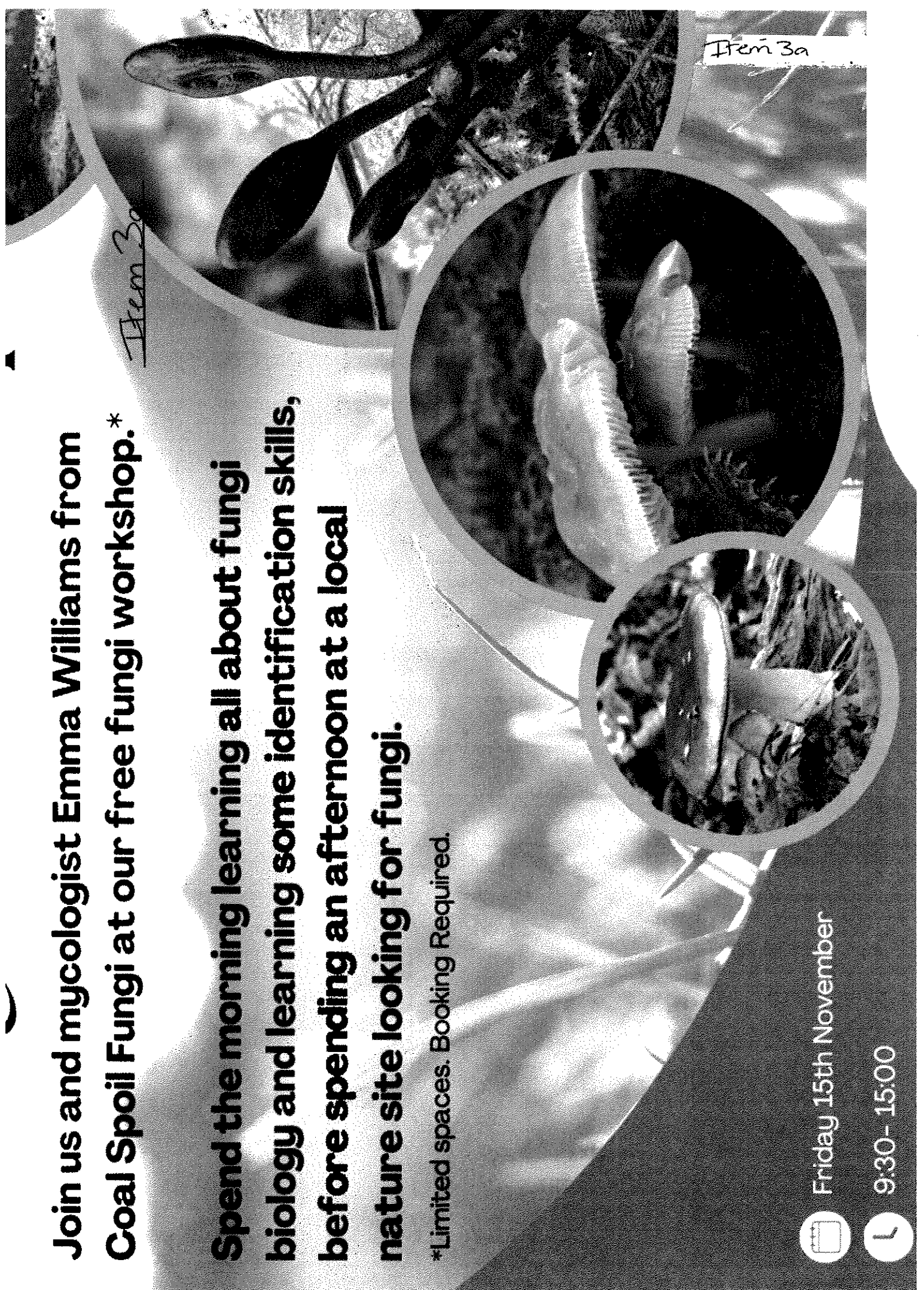

The SDP will function as a crucial link between the National Plan: Future Wales and Local Development Plans (LDPs), ensuring coherence and alignment with broader regional and national objectives. The draft Delivery Agreement marks the first step in the development of the SDP and sets out how and when stakeholders and the community can become involved in the plan-making process. It also includes a comprehensive timetable for its preparation, setting out clear timelines and milestones for key stages of the process.

As part of this process, we are carrying out two engagement events. These events will provide more information on the SDP process, the implications of the SDP to your community and discussion on the current consultation.

PAW is a registered charity that supports community engagement on planning matters in Wales. Planning Aid Wales will be independent and impartial organisation. We have extensive experience helping communities understand the planning system and to have their say. PAW recognises SDP preparation is an important avenue for securing more effective public involvement in planning.
