Review of polling districts and polling places/stations 2024

Background information

1 Background to the Review

Under the Representation of the People Act 1983 and 2013, the Council has a duty to divide its area into polling districts and to designate a polling place for each district. It also has to keep these arrangements under review. The Electoral Administration Act 2006 introduced a duty on all local authorities in Great Britain to review their polling districts and polling places.

2 Definitions

A polling district is a geographical area created by the sub-division of an electoral area, i.e. a constituency, district ward or division into smaller parts. A polling place is a building or area in which polling stations will be located. A polling station is the room or area within the polling place where voting takes place.

3 How the Review Is Conducted

The review will take place between 28 October 2024 and 1 February 2025.

The Acting Returning Officer will be consulted on the current arrangements and will make representations on the existing polling stations used. Her comments will be published as part of the review process.

County Borough Councillors, Community Councils, local political parties, residents and views from such persons who have particular expertise in relation to access to premises are invited to submit their representations.

4 What is not covered by the Review

The boundaries of parliamentary constituencies, electoral wards and Town/Community Council wards within Blaenau Gwent.

6 The Aim of the Review

The document attached sets out details of the current polling districts and polling places in Blaenau Gwent. The Council appreciates the cooperation of polling places in providing their building for the day so that electors have a convenient place to vote.

The Review seeks to address issues which have arisen, either due to the closure of buildings/proposed closure of buildings or issues arising during recent elections and will also be informed by feedback from polling station staff and inspectors.

7 Making Representations

When making representations, where a suggestion relates to the change of polling place, we would encourage you to give the reasons for this, and to suggest alternative polling places to allow further consultation. Similarly support for the current arrangements is also welcome.

Subject: Brynmawr Rotary - Christmas Hamper 2024 Funding request

Dear Members of Blaina and Nantyglo Town Council

Brynmawr Rotary has a proud history since it was formed in 1968 of assisting our wider community in various ways, and we continue to do so, an example of what we have done is the Christmas Hampers and our regular on-going emergency foodbank.

Christmas Hampers information

Christmas 2020 – we distributed **184 Christmas Hampers** which were suitable for 7 days with 3 meals a day across Blaenau Gwent which included festive items.

Christmas 2021

We distributed **200 plus** hampers and additional to this filled Councillor Waynes van with fifteen food parcels containing dried and tin products to cover emergencies in the period between Christmas and new year. These were also distributed when needed over Christmas.

Christmas 2022

We distributed over **328 parcels** on one day plus supported another twenty-five households during the Christmas period and utilised excess fruit cakes and donations to create additional parcels to give to our local care homes facilities.

Christmas 2023

We distributed over **383 parcels** on one day plus supported more than twenty-five more households during the Christmas period and utilised excess donations to support others in need in our very local community.

Christmas 2024

We have decided we have to continue to run this project as our everyday foodbank is far busier and this leads us to believe that we will need to provide hampers to households in need for this year – however our decision to change our Geographic provision has occurred and we now in both foodbank and Hampers terms are only supporting Brynmawr, Nantyglo and Blaina households.

So why do we write to you?

Brynmawr Rotary are asking for your considered support of this project via a financial donation and if any of you wish to volunteer to let us know so we can schedule you a suitable slot for hamper packing. If in doubt of what we did in 2020 - 2023 please ask your local Councillors - Cllr Behr, Cllr Baldwin and Cllr Morgan who participated in the efforts and know of the work needed to make this happen, and some helped bag the food into the hampers and helped with the hamper deliveries.

If you have questions or wish the project co-ordinators to speak to the Town Council at one time we would be delighted to do so physically or remotely. I can provide the bank details, or an office address should you wish to donate, and all donations will be acknowledged after the Hampers have been delivered.

We truly need your support to continue to offer this help to those who are not as fortunate as we may be, 'please' consider a donation to what we believe to be a more than worthy use of our community efforts.

**Appropriate Sum under Section 137(4)(a) of the Local Government Act 1972 -
Section 137 Expenditure Limit for 2025-26**

This is to notify you that the appropriate sum for the purposes of section 137(4)(a) of the Local Government Act 1972 (the 1972 Act) for Community and Town Councils in Wales for the financial year 2025-26 is £11.10

Section 137(1) of the 1972 Act permits each Community or Town Council to incur expenditure for purposes for which it has no other specific powers if the Council considers that the expenditure is in the interests of, and will bring direct benefit to, the area or any part of it, or all or some of its inhabitants, providing that the benefit is commensurate with the expenditure incurred. Community and Town Councils are also permitted under section 137(3) to incur expenditure for certain charitable and other purposes. The maximum expenditure that can be incurred under both section 137(1) and (3) for the financial year 2025-26 will be £11.10 per elector.

For the financial year 2025-26, the appropriate sum for the purposes of section 137(4)(a) is calculated by applying the formula set out in Schedule 12B to the 1972 Act. The Retail Prices Index increased by 2.68% between September 2023 and September 2024. This means that, by application of the formula, the appropriate sum for the financial year 2025-26 increases from £10.81 to £11.10 per elector.

For clarity, the Local Government and Elections (Wales) Act 2021 includes provision which enables 'eligible community councils' to exercise the General Power of Competence. The power for Community and Town Councils to exercise the General Power of Competence came into force on 5 May 2022.

The relevant **statutory guidance for community and town councils** explains the interaction between the two powers (i.e. the general power of competence and the power under s.137 of the 1972 Act). Community and town councils exercising the General Power of Competence are not subject to an expenditure limit, but other conditions apply. For all other community and town councils, the limit set out in this letter will apply.
