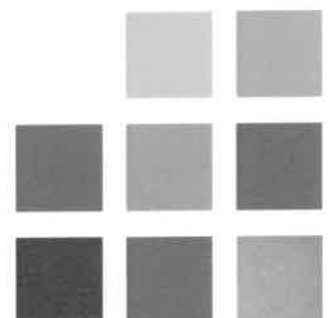


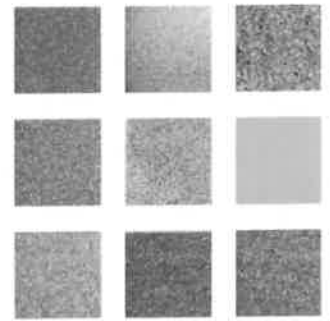

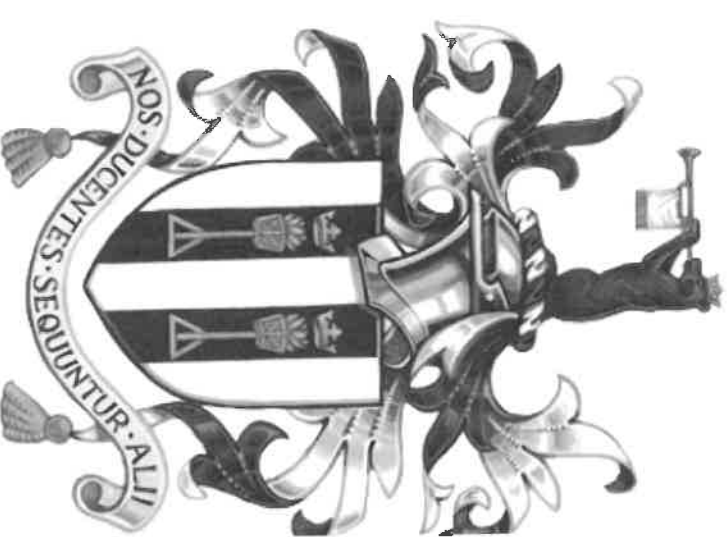

## Background



The Wales and the Battle of Britain Exhibition was created by the RAF's Air Historical Branch (Dr Lynsey Shaw), together with Air Commodore Williams, to commemorate Wales' contribution to victory in the Battle of Britain. It was originally planned to be launched in 2020, but had to be postponed many times due to the pandemic. Although we are now in the 81st anniversary year of the Battle of Britain, it was decided to go ahead with the planned exhibition launch, particularly as the Wales story had never before been told before as a single complete story to a Welsh audience.

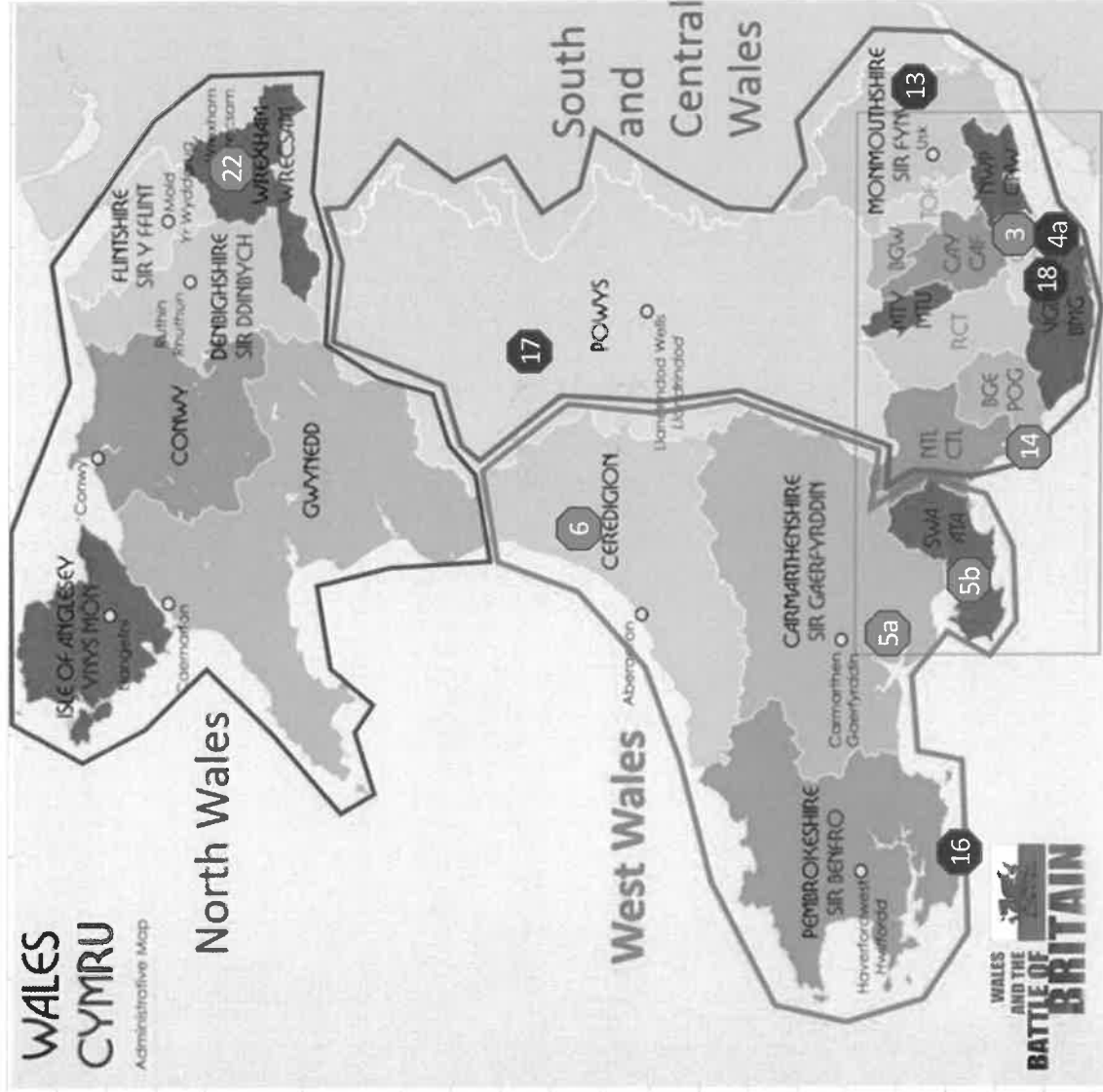
